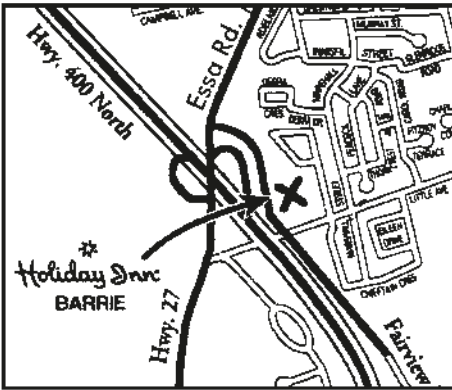

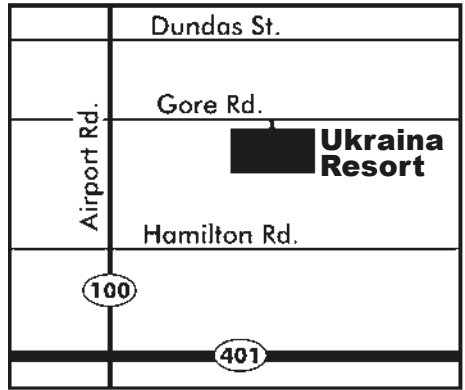

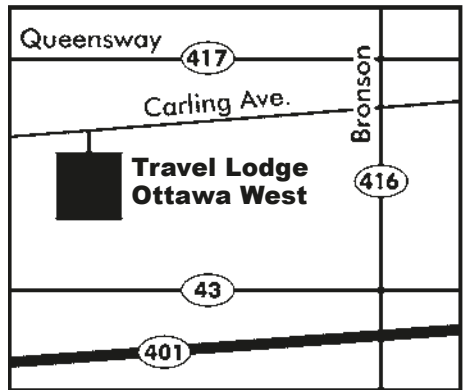

Growing Answers

Pam Charbonneau is a Turfgrass Specialist in the Crop Technology Branch with the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA), and keeps in constant touch with the industry through participation in seminars, committees and organizations. Pam is an Honorary Member of Landscape Ontario.

Erica Gunn is a Research Technician at the Guelph Turfgrass Institute (GTI) in charge of an IPM Lawn Demonstration trial and a Drought Tolerant Turfgrass Species trial. Erica is a frequent presenter at the GTI Research Field Day and is a volunteer with the Ontario Turfgrass Research Foundation and the Sports Turf Association.

Bob Kennedy has his own consulting business, Sports Turf Management Solutions and teaches part time at Niagara College. A graduate of the Niagara Parks Commission School of Horticulture and the University of Guelph, he is also the former Manager of Park Services for the City of St. Catharines.

Jennifer Llewellyn is a Nursery Crop Specialist with the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA), since May 1999. She is involved with the growing industry through participation in seminars, speaking engagements and committees.

Dr. Eric Lyons Dr. Lyons, a graduate of the University of Northern Iowa and Penn State, was awarded National Science Foundation and Golf Course Superintendents Association of America Watson Fellowships. He also was a postdoctoral associate at Rutgers University. In 2004 Dr. Lyons joined the faculty of the Department of Plant Agriculture at the University of Guelph and is currently teaching in the Diploma in Turfgrass Management Program and in the Department of Plant Agriculture.
