

Achillea Tutti Frutti collection

Tutti Frutti yarrow series

New 'Tutti Frutti' achilleas have been selected for their sturdy, compact growth habit. These vigorous, mound-forming plants have good branching and excellent flowering uniformity. They also boast a long bloom period, June through August, and are natural heat lovers. Zone 4.

'Apricot Delight'

Mature height is 33 cm (13 in.). Chameleon-like flowers come in a range of pinks from palest apricot to near red. Full sun intensifies the hues.



'Wonderful Wampee'

Mature height is 43 cm (15 in.). Opens as a rich pink, then ages gracefully to apple blossom blush.



'Strawberry Seduction'

Mature height is 45-50 cm (18-20 in.). Velvety red with bright gold centres. Thick, dark green foliage and sturdy stems.



Ajuga 'Black Scallop'

'Black Scallop' bugleweed

'Black Scallop' is a stunning jet-black groundcover with very dark, uniform, glossy scalloped foliage and a dense compact habit. An added bonus is its highly reflective sheen on the jet-black colored leaves in winter. The foliage



colour is intensified both in full sun and cold temperatures. It is topped in late spring/early summer with intense deep blue flowers. 'Black Scallop' is an excellent container and accent plant for the sunny garden.

Anemone sylvestris 'Elise Feldman'

'Elise Feldman' anemone

A new look for anemone. Pompom-like, double white flowers above lush green foliage that bloom for up to two months in the spring and repeat again in the fall. Grows 35 cm (14 in.) tall. Zone 4.



Astilbe chinensis 'Diamonds and Pearls'

'Diamonds and Pearls' false spirea

Astilbe chinensis 'Diamonds and Pearls' is the first pure-white chinensis species *Astilbe*. Large-petalled silver-white flowers fill long, upright plumes, which are held on thick stems over dark-green foliage. It's a very floriferous plant, with all the robust growing qualities associated with *A. chinensis*, making it the toughest pure-white *Astilbe* in existence. Grows 70 cm (28 in.) tall and 55 cm (22 in.) wide.

Calamagrostis acutiflora (×) 'Eldorado' **Eldorado feather reed grass**

This new form has bright golden foliage with a green edge and superb vigour and colour in the garden. It is one of the most colourful *Calamagrostis*. It is easy to grow and hardy to Zone 4. Photo courtesy of Walters.



Campanula takesimana 'Pink Octopus' **'Pink Octopus' bellflower**

Japanese lantern buds open to striking pink, octopus-like flowers. Over 50 blooms flutter down from the nicely upright flowering branches above strong, deeply cut foliage. Unique and interesting. 'Pink Octopus' has a long bloom time and easy to grow. Tolerant of most soils. Zone 6.



Coreopsis 'Limerock Dream' **'Limerock Dream' tickseed**

Exceptional flower power, unique hue and uniform habit. Neat mounds of narrow, rich green foliage are usually hidden from June to October under a generous layer of flowers. Daisy-shaped blooms start out apricot pink in spring, mellowing to coppery orange in summer's heat. Grows 30-45 cm (12-18 in.) tall by 80 cm (32 in.) wide in full sun. Variable hardiness, best grown as a tender perennial.



Corydalis sp. 'Berry Exciting' **'Berry Exciting' corydalis**

Brilliant yellow, fern-like leaves are streaked green and erupt in fragrant purple flowers. This wonderful new mutation of *C. 'Blackberry Wine'* is one of the few *Corydalis* that does not go summer dormant. Its vigorous cascading habit makes it an excellent ground cover and looks great spilling out of baskets and over banks. Does best in rich, well drained soil with good moisture. Zone 6.



Delphinium New Millennium hybrids **New Millennium delphinium hybrids**

These new and improved F1 hybrids have stronger, thicker stems and larger, heavily petalled flowers. They have been chosen as they are longer-lived than most delphiniums, and are hardy to Zone 3. Photos courtesy of Jelitto Perennial Seeds.

Dendranthema Igloo series

Igloo Arctic daisy

A breakthrough in breeding has produced hardy *Dendranthema* with a domed growth habit and mass of flowers. Uniform flowering with weeks of solid colour begins in mid-September the first year and mid-August the second year. No pinching needed in the garden! Mature plants grow to 60 cm (24 in.) tall by 75 cm (30 in.) wide. Full sun. Zone 6.

'Rosy Igloo'

Rich, red duplex daisy flowers.



'Sunny Igloo'

Fluffy duplex daisy flowers of bright yellow.



'Warm Igloo'


Burnished bronze duplex daisy blooms.



Echinacea 'Merlot'

'Merlot' coneflower

Like a fine wine, 'Merlot' entices us with many delicious traits. Most noticeable are the sturdy, nearly black stems that erupt in a bouquet of very large rose-pink flowers. The lavish branching assures masses of fragrant, long lasting flowers for the summer garden. Cut flower lovers should take note of the huge cones, the extended bloom period, and the quality of the blossoms. Zone 4.

Echinacea 'Pink Double Delight' **'Pink Double Delight' coneflower**

An explosion of fragrant, pink, fully double pompom-like flowers with straight, sturdy stems reaches a maximum height of 60 cm (24 in). Bloom face measures 12.5 cm (5 in.) but with large centres they look even bigger. Long lasting cut flowers from early summer to mid-fall. Suitable for full sun to partial shade. Zone 3.



Echinacea 'Raspberry Tart' **'Raspberry Tart' coneflower**

Like its pastry namesake, 'Raspberry Tart' is compact and full of surprises. In summer, deep magenta flowers adorn this well branched wonder. These blooms carry a lovely aroma and are very effective when massed along a pathway or border. Looking for a sturdy long-blooming plant for your containers? 'Raspberry Tart' fills the bill, and won't overwhelm others in the pot. Zone 4.



Echinacea 'Evan Saul' **Sundown™ coneflower**

Sundown™ coneflower offers a prolific spread of intense, long-flowering orange blooms with prominent brown central cones on tall, stout stems. Delightfully fragrant blooms attract butterflies and are superb as a cut flower. An exceptionally hardy perennial border or container favourite. Grows up to 100 cm (40 in.) in full sun or partial shade. Zone 4.



Euphorbia **'Tasmanian Tiger' spurge**

This terrific selection has been around for a couple of years but not always readily available. 'Tasmanian Tiger' features evergreen leaves, strongly edged with creamy white, forming an upright, bushy mound. Conical flower heads appear in spring, made up of creamy bracts with a green eye. A very exotic, fabulous plant for containers. A tender perennial. Height and spread is 75-90 cm (30-36 in.) but smaller in cooler climates.



Geranium 'Pink Penny' **'Pink Penny' hardy geranium**

'Pink Penny' has large, open-faced, cup-shaped pink flowers with a white centre. Blooms continuously from June through October. Foliage colours attractively in fall. Grows 40 cm (16 in.) tall. Zone 4



Geranium 'Sweet Heidy' **'Sweet Heidy' hardy geranium**

'Sweet Heidy' is a new hybrid hardy geranium from Dutch breeder Marco van Noort with distinct white centres surrounded by pink, which fuses into blue, with an overlay of dramatic dark veins completing the look. The variety is the result of several crossings, including *G. wallichianum* which is responsible for giving it an exceptionally long blooming season and sprawling habit.

It is a good plant for border fronts, hanging baskets and other containers. Blooms from May to September, grows 34 cm (14 in.) tall and spreads 45 cm (18 in.) wide.

Hemerocallis 'Cherry Valentine' 'Cherry Valentine' daylily

The clean pink petal colour frames the intense dark eye and ruffled red edge of these 10 cm (4 in.) blooms. Typical bud count is 25-28 on each plant and every bloom is virtually perfect. The tall erect scapes have deep, well-spaced branches. Dark green foliage, re-blooming, tetraploid-type. Grows 60 cm (24 in.) tall. Zone 3.



Hemerocallis 'Jungle Beauty' 'Jungle Beauty' daylily



A selection from the Trophytaker™ line, 'Jungle Beauty' features 15 cm (6 in.) nearly black blooms with a yellow throat on 75 cm (30 in.) scapes. One of the blackest daylilies available on the market. All Trophytaker daylilies must bloom a minimum of 42 days, double the average of most other daylilies. Height 70-75 cm (28-30 in.), spread 65-70 cm (26-28 in.). Hardy to at least Zone 5.

Hemerocallis 'Rooten Tooten Red' 'Rooten Tooten Red' daylily

One of the Trophytaker™ daylilies, 'Rooten Tooten Red' boasts 10 cm (4 in.) fire-

engine red blooms on a compact plant. Blooms more prolifically and for longer than most other red daylilies – all Trophytaker varieties must bloom at least 42 days. Grows to 60 cm (24 in.) tall with a spread of 80 cm (32 in.). Hardy to at least Zone 5.

Hemerocallis 'Stella Stars' 'Stella Stars' daylily

A tetraploid 'Stella D'Oro'. With firmer foliage, the blooms are more intense in colour and the flowers are larger and last longer than Stella D'Oro. Grows 10 in. (25 cm) tall. Blooms through June to August. Zone 3.



standard hybrids. Easy to grow, and tolerates some dry shade. Height 30-45 cm (12-18 in.), spread 45-60 cm (18-24 in.). Hardy to Zone 6.

Heuchera 'Café Olé' 'Café Olé' coral bells

Darkest milk chocolate ruffled leaves form a tight mound on this unusual new hybrid. Numerous branched spikes hold hundreds of white flowers kissed with purple. Great for edging a pathway or *en masse*. Zone 3.



Helleborus 'Double Vision' 'Double Vision' Lenten rose

Named Perennial Plant of the Year for 2005, Hellebores are the queens of the shady spring garden. 'Double Vision' features double and semi-double blooms in shades of white to pink, rose, red and maroon, much different than the commonly seen



Heuchera 'Ginger Ale' 'Ginger Ale' coral bells

Full, ruffled, silver-veiled ginger foliage with effervescent flowers in shades of ginger, yellow and pink. Perfect for use in shade or partial shade gardens, containers and borders. Attractive to butterflies and hummingbirds. Grows up to 30 cm (12 in.) tall with flowers up to 55 cm (22 in.) tall and a 40 cm (16 in.) spread. Zone 4.



Heuchera 'Midnight Rose' 'Midnight Rose' coral bells



Hot pink polka dots adorn this vigorous growing 'Obsidian' sport. Pink flecks emerge in spring and lighten to cream as the season progresses. Bold, black, and beautiful for sunny locations. Zone 4.

Hibiscus Cordial series

Cordial hardy hibiscus

Dramatic foliage hues and shapes, cut like maple leaves, bring a new look to hardy garden hibiscus. Four varieties, each with outstanding full habit and big blooms, 20-25 cm (8-10 in.) across, offer an intoxicating blast of colour. Sturdy, erect plants grow up to 100 cm (3 ft.) tall and 90 cm (3 ft.) wide. Heat loving, with flowers blooming in July and August. Full sun. Zone 6.

'Cinnamon Grappa'

Large, robust green foliage, cut like maple leaves, on well-branched vigorous plants. Big, solid-red blooms. The shortest of the group.



'Peppermint Schnapps'

Same habit and distinctively cut, green foliage as above. Large pink flowers are accented with darker pink stripes and smears. Tallest of the group.



'Brandy Punch'

Leaves are big, bold and bronze, with purple and green accents. Plants are full and generously self-branching, making a unique backdrop for huge pink flowers.



'Cherry Brandy'

Same outstanding foliage as 'Brandy Punch', with solid red blooms. Typically the latest to flower, a week to 10 days after the others.

Hibiscus Fireball®

Fireball® hardy hibiscus

Large flowers are an intense fiery-red. The fine textured foliage is elegant with a purplish blush. Flowers from June-September, grows 100 cm (40 in.) tall. Zone 4.

Hosta 'Lakeside Spellbinder'

'Lakeside Spellbinder' hosta

'Lakeside Spellbinder' forms a striking, medium-sized mound of heart-shaped foliage with a strong white centre. Medium to fast growing with good substance. White flowers. Height 35 cm (14 in.), spread 80 cm (32 in.). Hardy to Zone 3.



Hosta 'Blue Mouse Ears'

'Blue Mouse Ears' hosta

This is an extremely cute, distinctive new small hosta that has nearly perfectly rounded foliage. It makes a tight mound of 3 cm (1.25 in.), round blue-green leaves on a perfectly symmetrical clump.



plant profiles

Daylily

Height: 25-100 cm (10-39 in.)
Spread: 30-90 cm (12-36 in.)
Exposure: sun

There are thousands of varieties of this popular, easy-to-grow perennial in nearly every size and colour imaginable. Daylilies are standards in an old-fashioned garden, known for their multitude of short-lived blooms, but recent developments in breeding have created cultivars that bloom for a longer period or re-bloom later in the summer. They are tolerant of a wide variety of soil conditions, but do best in fertile, well-drained soil. Even when daylilies aren't blooming, their long grass-like leaves add a fine texture to the garden. Plant a row of low-growing varieties as a border along the front of the garden, while groupings of taller daylilies should be set farther back. Deadhead the spent flowers occasionally.



The foliage is strong and is resistant to snails. Flowers in June and July, grows 20 cm (8 in.) tall. Zone 3.

Hosta 'Kiwi Full Monty'

'Kiwi Full Monty' hosta

This is a new sport of 'Striptease' with a much more prominent cream margin around the kiwi-coloured centre. Selected because it performs much better than its parent. Produces lavender flowers in June and July. Grows 45 cm (18 in.) tall. Zone 4.



Hosta 'Sleeping Beauty'

'Sleeping Beauty' hosta

A new sport developed from 'Halcyon'. The pointed foliage is a good strong blue with yellowish-margins. It is also slug resistant. Lavender flowers in June and July. Grows 40 cm (16 in.). Zone 3.



Hosta 'Woolly Mammoth'

'Woolly Mammoth' hosta

A gorgeous sport of 'Big Mammoth' with thick corrugated blue-green leaves and wide gold margins. A big hosta that can get 1.5 m (5 ft.) across. Excellent slug resistance. White flowers. Hardy to Zone 3. Height 75 cm (30 in.), spread 150 cm (5 ft.).



Iris ensata 'Freckled Geisha'

'Freckled Geisha' iris

Huge flowers 15 cm (6 in.) in diameter, with lavender edges and random splashes of lavender throughout the white petals. Noticeable golden-yellow signals. Grows 70 cm (28 in.) tall. Zone 3.



Lavender angustifolia 'Violet Intrigue'

'Violet Intrigue' lavender

Bred by lavender specialist Virginia McNaughton, this is a perfect variety for hedges, perennial gardens, drying and scented oils. Up to 45 cm (18 in.) tall and 60 cm (24 in.) across, 'Violet Intrigue' is extremely floriferous with intense purple blooms.

Leucanthemum maximum 'Golddrausch' 'Golddrausch' daisy

Large, shiny foliage complements compact, fine-petaled, semi-double white blooms with a centre layer of golden petals. A fragrant favourite that will bloom throughout the summer. A striking addition to any perennial border or container garden and an excellent cut flower. Thrives in full sun. Grows up to 35 cm (14 in.). Zone 4.



Lilium 'Starburst' 'Starburst' Asiatic lily

Enormous rich red flowers speckled with black markings. Very high bud count per stem. Grows 100 cm (40 in.).



Lilium 'Dot Com' 'Dot Com' Asiatic lily

Enormous, delicate pink flowers speckled with maroon markings. Very high bud count per stem. Grows 100 cm (40 in.).



Lobelia 'Monet Moment' 'Monet Moment' cardinal flower

The perennial *Lobelias* have upright spikes of large flowers, not at all like the more familiar trailing types. This tall selection bears deep rose-pink flowers through late summer and fall, over dark-green leaves. Mulch well in winter in colder climates. Clumps are easily divided in the spring. Attractive to butterflies and hummingbirds. Height 75-90 cm (30-36 in.), spread 50-60 cm (20-24 in.). Zone 5.

Cranesbill

Height: 10-75 cm (4-30 in.)
Spread: 10-120 cm (4-48 in.)
Exposure: light shade preferred

Also known as the hardy geranium, this perennial shouldn't be confused with the annual geranium used in summer plantings. Cranesbill is a low-maintenance, long-lived plant that makes a great mounding groundcover in a mixed border, rock garden or woodland garden. There are many different varieties, but most come in varying shades of white, pink, purple or blue. Read the label to determine bloom time and preferred light conditions as they differ between varieties. Some cranesbills have outstanding fall colour.



Matteuccia struthiopteris 'Jumbo' 'Jumbo' ostrich fern

This special form of the native ostrich fern is wonderful for creating a dramatic effect in moist, shady areas. The plume-like fronds are up to 50 per cent larger than the species, deep green, forming an upright clump. Brownish fertile fronds appear in the centre. Requires plenty of water through the summer. A deciduous fern that is equally attractive in the garden or containers. Grows 90-180 cm tall (36-72 in.) and spreads 90-120 cm (36-48 in.) wide. Hardy to Zone 3.

Miscanthus sinensis 'Gold Bar' 'Gold Bar' zebra grass

This is a new form of the popular porcupine and zebra grass with greater amounts of golden-yellow bands, making it more colourful than other varieties. Hardy to Zone 5. Photo courtesy of Walters Gardens.

Miscanthus sinensis 'Mysterious Maiden' 'Mysterious Maiden' zebra grass

A graceful, beautifully variegated form of *Miscanthus*, the most popular genus of all ornamental grasses. Slender foliage, generously adorned with golden crosshatching. 'Mysterious Maiden' is the perfect size: large enough to make a statement in any garden, but not so big that it will overwhelm smaller borders. Foliage grows to 120 cm (4 ft.) topped by another foot of graceful buff plumes. Spreads to 100 cm (3.5 ft) after two years. Full sun. Zone 5.



Nepeta subsessilis 'Pink Dreams' Pink Dreams catmint

This is a lovely dwarf form of the species, with clusters of bright pink flowers. It is easy to grow and is hardy to Zone 4. Photo courtesy of Jelitto Perennial Seeds.



Paeonia 'Lilac Morning' Itoh peony hybrid

Another amazing colour brought to you by the breeder of 'Bartzella' and 'Yellow Crown'. Itoh's hybrid 'Lilac Morning' is a cross between a herbaceous peony and a tree peony. The result is a plant with enormous, vivid 15 cm (6 in.) magenta-purple blooms of a tree peony but on a strong herbaceous plant with exceptional hardiness. Tissue culture has made these hybrids more widely available at an accessible price. Height 65-75cm (26-30 in.), and spreads 80 cm (32 in.). Hardy to Zone 4.

Panicum virgatum 'Prairie Fire' 'Prairie Fire' switch grass

This new and improved cultivar turns red by early summer — the soonest of any form. This grass is best planted in groups of at least three. It is hardy to Zone 4. Photo courtesy of Walters Gardens.

Phlox 'Magic Blue' **'Magic Blue' phlox**

Very unusual, intriguing flowers that change from one colour to another. The blooms start with dark lavender outer petals and a lighter eye but mature to a softer lavender outer petal with a dark eye. Flowers from June through September. Grows 90 cm (36 in.) tall. Zone 3.



Phlox paniculata 'Peppermint Twist' **'Peppermint Twist' perennial phlox**

A striking new *paniculata* hybrid perennial phlox, 'Peppermint Twist' is a real head-turner with its large clusters of pink and white striped flowers. While the colouring has been around for some time in the form of *P. maculata* 'Natascha', 'Peppermint Twist's *P. paniculata* bloodline makes it a considerably stronger, healthier, more reliable plant. Growing to just 40 cm (16 in.) high, 'Peppermint Twist' is a very short variety, making it versatile for use in smaller gardens. Blooms from July to September.



Phlox paniculata hybrid 'Sherbet Cocktail' **'Sherbet Cocktail' perennial phlox**

Phlox 'Sherbet Cocktail' is the first perennial phlox to show yellow in its petals. It's actually a bit of a chameleon, forming yellow buds encased in chocolate-maroon bracts which open to reveal flowers with a yellow-green edge and centres which may be either white or pink. The flowers have a slightly waxy appearance, similar to hydrangea. 'Sherbet Cocktail' has large, tight flower clusters crowning upright stems. It also grows with the strength of *P. paniculata* and has good resistance to mildew. Blooms from July to September and grows 70 cm (28 in.) tall.



Salvia nemorosa **'Sensation Rose' Sage**

Sedum 'Bon Bon'
'Bon Bon' stonecrop

A new selection from the Netherlands, this stonecrop produces a low mound of succulent chocolate purple leaves. Small clusters of dusty-rose flowers appear by midsummer, lasting into the autumn before changing into brown seed heads for winter. Excellent for edging sunny borders or in containers. Excellent drought tolerance. Best foliage colour in full sun. Height and spread 30-40cm (12-16 in.). Hardy to Zone 4.





Cercis canadensis 'Hearts of Gold' **'Hearts of Gold' redbud**

A *Cercis canadensis* with gold foliage. Its early hot-pink blooms emerge before the foliage, making this a great specimen plant in the landscape in several seasons. New growth is gold turning green with age. Mature height is 4.5 m (15 ft.) and grows 3 m (10 ft.) within the first five years. A pendulous growth habit. 'Hearts of Gold' does well in full sun and well-drained soils. Drought tolerant. Hardy to Zone 5.




Cornus alba 'Crmezam' **Crème de Mint™ Siberian dogwood**

Crème de Mint™ has mint-green summer foliage accented with creamy-white margins. The showy golden chartreuse stems add winter interest. Slower growing than straight *Cornus alba*, Crème de Mint™ will grow to 150 cm (5 ft.) tall and wide. Hardy to Zone 4. A Care Free Maintenance™ plant requiring little or no pruning.



Cornus alba 'Stdazam' **Strawberry Daiquiri™ Siberian dogwood**

Strawberry Daiquiri™ has burgundy stems with green and creamy-white foliage. Growing in a naturally rounded shape, it can reach 1.8-2.4 m. (6-8 ft. tall). Adaptable to many growing conditions, salt tolerant with good insect and disease resistance. A Care Free Maintenance™ plant requiring little or no pruning. Hardy to Zone 4.



Cornus stolonifera 'Farrow' **Arctic Fire™ dogwood**

A new compact selection of red stem dogwood with dark red winter twigs and a compact, non-suckering habit. Grows in full sun to partial shade. A great choice for small yards. 100 cm (4 ft.) tall and wide. Hardy to Zone 4.

Euonymus alatus 'Pipzám' **Pipsqueak® dwarf burning bush**

Pipsqueak® is a new, compact-growing, dwarf burning bush with horizontal branching, reaching 120-150 cm (4-5 ft.) high and wide at maturity. The low round habit is dense in texture and smaller than the traditional compact burning bush. This is excellent for small areas where size is a consideration. Stunning in a woodland garden, the plant bears intense crimson red fall foliage. Hardy to Zone 5.

Forsythia x 'Mindor' **Show Off™ forsythia**

Covered with abundant, large, golden flowers and dark green foliage, this lovely new forsythia is a compact, rounded plant with a full and showy flower display from the ground up. Reaches a mature height of 90-180 cm (3-6 ft.). A beautiful cut flower and does best in full sun. Hardy to Zone 4.



Hydrangea Cityline™ Series **Cityline™ hydrangea**

Tired of floppy, weak-stemmed hydrangeas? The Cityline series is the answer. Gardeners are able to have a tight, full plant without growth regulators, shearing or pruning off flower buds. Large flowers with vivid colours, strong stems and dark glossy foliage characterizes these new German hybrids. Also noted for

Physocarpus oppertina 'Mindia' **Coppertina™ ninebark**

An accent shrub with coppery-orange foliage that turns a fiery rich red in fall. The outstanding foliage is the draw, but Coppertina™ is dotted with pinkish-white flowers in summer. Grows 175 cm (6 ft.) tall and 150 cm (4 ft.) wide in full sun. Hardy to Zone 3.



Sambucus nigra 'Eva'

Black Lace™ elder

Sambucus Black Lace™ is an easy-growing, durable shrub with dark lacy, finely-cut leaves. The foliage is accented by creamy pink flowers that turn into red berries in the fall. Berries can be used to make wine or jam, or left on the plants for the birds to enjoy. An adaptable plant that takes pruning well and can be grouped to form a dramatic hedge. Grows 1.8-2.4 m. (6-8 ft.) tall in full sun for best colour. Hardy to Zone 5.



Weigela florida 'Bramwell'

Fine Wine™ weigela

This new weigela has the same great dark burgundy foliage of Wine and Roses, but with a compact mounded habit similar to *Spiraea japonica*. It's a refined plant with smaller leaves, abundant pink flowers and excellent texture. A great plant for the front of the border, the perennial bed, or used as a low foundation plant. Reaches a mature height of 60 cm (2 ft.). Best in full sun. Hardy to Zone 5.







Also known as Madagascar periwinkle, this summer-flowering annual gives great results with minimal effort — no pinching or deadheading required. The glossy green leaves set off the single phlox-like blooms beautifully. Annual vinca will tolerate pollution and dust from street traffic, so it is an ideal choice for front gardens. Vinca is drought tolerant, but prefers regular watering. These tropical plants prefer warm weather, so don't put them out in the garden too early in spring.

Sweet potato vine

Height: 20-30 cm (8-12 in.)
Spread: 1.5 m. (5 ft.)
Exposure: sun to partial shade

The ornamental sweet potato vine is enjoying a boost in popularity thanks to continued interest in container gardening. As a foliage accent, these vines are unparalleled in their versatility. They are most commonly used as the "spiller" in window boxes and patio pots, but the rapid growth rate of ornamental sweet potatoes makes them a useful annual groundcover as well. Rosa 'BAIsta'

Fiesta, Garden Jubilee® shrub rose

Like little fireworks, each bloom explodes in an array of dark pink and white stripes with just a touch of yellow near the centres. Dark green, glossy foliage is disease-resistant and complements the flowers well. Unique blooms flower early and hold their colour and petals as they mature. Plant in groups for best flower effect. Grown on own root. Hardy to Zone 4.



Rosa 'Emily Carr'

'Emily Carr' shrub rose

'Emily Carr' is one of the first varieties from the new Canadian Artists series of hardy roses. This upright shrub covers itself in clusters of large, deep red blooms all season.
